Wife was Eliza also Wilson (c1835-1898). Lived North Harbor Street.
Wilson, Robert (c1802-1882) Wife was Jane (c1806-1881). Lived Gould Lane area.
Winthrop, Thomas (c1821-) Wife was Laura (c1821-).
Wise, Joseph (c1833-) Wife was Elizabeth (c1833-). Lived Branford center.

1860 Federal Census- Branford M653-85, pages 873-926

The 1860 census is the second federal census to include members of every household, however, relationships are not given. The census includes, sex, age, occupation, color, state/country of birth and value of assets.

The pages for the census are pre-printed with columns and each row is numbered. There are 40 lines per page in the 1860 census. The page number is the one in the upper right corner of the page. Jay E. Russell was the enumerator and his spelling and writing is fairly good. There is some difficulty distinguishing between N/M/U, H/F/K and R/P. A female named Louise is written as Louis. There are a few errors of birth places where a "do" mark is used from the previous entry. These errors are noted below.

The dwelling and household numbers for Branford do not start with one, but continue from East Haven which was part of the Branford post office at that time. Branford begins on page 873 with dwelling 663 and family 745. The total number of males and females on each page are added together, but a figure for the total population is not given.

This writer has transcribed the census and analyzed the genealogy of the people in Branford. There was a growing number of new residents, particularly from Europe. Many of these new residents first appear in the 1860 census but are gone by the 1870 census.

A study of older homes in town, land records, family records and an 1856 map provides information as to the street addresses of the inhabitants. The neighborhood a person lived in can also be ascertained by the route the enumerator took. It is noted when a family member appears to have lived next to and near a relative. Paved Street refers to the section of the current Leetes Island Road toward East Main Street. This section of town was called the Paved Street District. The Lock Works was a factory at East Main and Ivy Streets where many Irish men worked.

The enumerator started the census in Branford at Short Rocks, through Pine Orchard to Pleasant Point (pages 873-876) and continued to part of Stony Creek. Another day he started in the center of town, to Brushy Plain and Mill Plain (pages 877-879). He comes back to the center of town (pages 881-886). That same day he moves along Harbor Street to Branford Point (pages 887-890). He again records some families from the center of town and heads along East Main Street to Short Rocks (pages 891-897). Two days later he begins in Branford Point, moving to Double Beach and Short Beach where only a few families lived (page 898) and north along Alps Road (page 899). He returns to Branford center along Main Street (pages 900-903) including various side streets. He moves south along Montowese Street (pages 904-906) onto Indian Neck where only a few families lived in the 1860 (page 907). On July 16th he heads out toward Guilford along East Main Street (pages 908 and 909). On July 17th he starts back at the center of town at 124 Main Street and heads west to Branford Hills (pages 910 and 911). On another day he enumerates most of Stony Creek (pages 910-919) and part of Damascus (pages 920 and 921). The rest of the Branford census (pages 922-926) appear to be families living past the current library along Main Street to the Bradley Street triangle.
