Cline (Kline), Lewis M. (1831-1922) Wife was Sarah E. Monroe (1841-1917). Lived Harbor Street. In the 1860 census.

Coe, Eben/Ebenezer J. (1817-1889) son of Elias & Hannah (Tryon) Coe
Wife was Phebe Birdsey (1819-1907). Lived 4 Three Elms Road, Stony Creek. In the 1860 census.

Collins, Catharine (c1830-) Lived Branford center by herself.

Collins, Jonathan (1799-1873) son of Friend & Philany (Norton) Collins

Desmond, Catherine (c1828-) nee McKenna, widow of John Desmond
Had a boarding house in Branford center. In the 1860 census.

Dickerson, Calvin (c1846-) Lived Short Rocks area. Living with him was Lydia

1870 Federal Census- Branford M593-111, pages 16A-47A

The 1870 federal census includes members of every household, however, relationships are not given. The census includes, sex, age, occupation, color, state/country of birth and value of assets. Nearly all of the women in the census have the occupation of “keeping house”. This is distinguished from “does housework” as a livelihood.

The pages for the census are pre-printed with columns and each row is numbered. There are 40 lines per page in the 1870 census. The page number is stamped in the upper right corner of the page. Andrew J. Granniss was the assistant marshal and his spelling and writing is fairly good. There is some difficulty distinguishing between the letters L/S, F/T and N/M/U particularly for middle initials. On a few pages the ink is faint. Ages are sometimes difficult to distinguish between 4, 1 or 3. Unlike the 1860 census, the dwelling and household numbers for Branford start with one.

This writer has transcribed the census and analyzed the genealogy of the people in Branford. The 1870 census shows that the children of the original Irish immigrants are getting married and starting families. The Irish families lived primarily in the center of town in and around the Lock Works on Main near East Main Street and at the 4th Ward. There is very little increase of new immigrants from other areas of Europe since the 1860 census.

A study of older homes in town, land records, family records and an 1868 map provides information as to the street addresses of the inhabitants. The neighborhood a person lived in can also be ascertained by the route the enumerator took. It is noted when a family member appears to have lived next to and near a relative. Paved Street refers to the section of the current Leetes Island Road toward East Main Street. This section of town was called the Paved Street District.

The enumerator Albert Granniss was from East Haven, and started the Branford 1870 census at the border of the two towns. He went through Branford Hills (page 16A), down Alps Road to Short Beach and back out to Branford Hills moving east (pages 16B-18A). There were only a few families living in Short Beach in 1870. He traveled through Double Beach, to Maple Street (pages 18B) to Harbor Street from the north to the south on the west side of the street (pages 19A-19B). He moved north back out Harbor Street recording the families on the east side of the street to North Harbor Street toward West Main (now Main Street, pages 20A-21B). A number of families lived in the Bradley Street area (pages 22A) and the enumerator moved onto the side streets in the center (pages 22B-23A) and along Main Street and South Main Street (pages 23B-24B).

From the center of Branford Granniss moved up to Brushy Plains and Short Rocks (page 25A-26A) but then comes back to the center (pages 26B-27B) along some of East Main Street (pages 27A). The families on Montowese Street are recorded next (pages 27B-28B). He stays in the center of town (pages 29A-29B) and moved father east on East Main Street (pages 30A). Granniss does further work in the center (pages 30B-34B) and heads toward Indian Neck (pages 35A-36A) and Pine Orchard (pages 36B). Damascus (page 37A) and some more families in Brushy Plains and Short Rocks are enumerated (pages 37B-38B). Albert Granniss then heads to the center of Stony Creek (pages 39A-41A) including the quarry living quarters (page 40A). He continues north on Paved Street (pages 41B-42A), along East Main Street (pages 42B-43A) to Mill Plain and Queach (pages 43B-44B). He finishes his route with more families along East Main Street (pages 45A-46A) and finishes at Damascus (pages 46B-47A).
