**1880 Federal Census**  
**T9:107, pages 526A-558B**

The 1880 federal census includes members of every household and for the first time includes relationships and birthplace of the parents of each person. The census includes, sex, age, occupation, color, and state or country of birth. Nearly all of the women in the census have the occupation of “keeping house”.

The pages for the census are pre-printed with columns and each row is numbered. There are 36 lines per page in the 1880 census. The page number is stamped in the upper right corner of the page. William E. Hatch was the enumerator for the 1880 census and his spelling and writing is good. He took the census in Branford from June 1 to July 5, 1880. The population was 3047.

This writer has transcribed the census and analyzed the genealogy of the people in Branford. The 1880 census shows that the children of the original Irish immigrants are getting married and starting families. The Irish families lived primarily in the center of town in and around the Lock Works on Main Street near East Main Street and at the 4<sup>th</sup> Ward.

There is a great influx of new residents in town during this period coming to work at the Lock Works and at the MIF (Malleable Iron Fittings Company). 1880 marks the beginning of other immigrants coming from Europe such as Germans and Scandinavians. There is also a lot of development in the center of Branford to accommodate these new residents. Old time Branford families are beginning to spread out, moving uptown and away from the family farms to work in the factories. There appears to be a decrease in the number of children per household.

A study of older homes in town, land records, and family records provides information as to the street addresses of the inhabitants. The neighborhood a person lived in can also be ascertained by the route the enumerator took. It is noted when a family member appears to have lived next to and near a relative. Paved Street refers to the section of the current Leetes Island Road toward East Main Street. This section of town was called the Paved Street District.
