Bishop, David C. (1814-1884) son of Jonathan & Julia (Tyler) Bishop
Wife was Lucretia Baldwin (1812-1873). Lived East Main Street at Featherbed Lane. In the 1840 census.

Bishop, John (1818-1895) son of Jonathan & Julia (Tyler) Bishop

census is now living with him. In the 1840 census.

1850 Federal Census M432-45

The enumerator was Benjamin P. Foote. The 1850 census is the first federal census to name all the members of a household. Relationships to the head of household are not given. The census includes, sex, age, occupation, color, state/country of birth and value of assets. There is also a column for attending school or if a person is a pauper.

The pages for the census are pre-printed with columns and each row is numbered. There are 42 lines per page in the 1850 census. The penmanship of the enumerator is poor, especially for ages. 1, 2 and 3 all look similar, as do 2 and 5, 4 and 9. The age given by the census taker should be checked with other records.

This writer has transcribed the census and analyzed the genealogy of the people in Branford. The total population in the 1850 was 1423, with 278 dwellings and 298 families. There were only 12 free colored people in Branford in the 1850- 8 males and 4 females, nearly all members of the Prince B. Warner family of Branford Point. The place of birth for nearly all residents is still Connecticut. European immigration to this country has begun, 45 people giving Ireland as the place of birth. There are only a few other birth countries listed- England, Scotland, and Canada.

A study of older homes in town, land records, family records and an 1856 map provides information as to the street addresses of the inhabitants. The neighborhood a person lived in can also be ascertained by the route the enumerator took. It is noted when a family member appears to have lived next to and near a relative. Paved Street refers to the section of the current Leetes Island Road toward East Main Street. This section of town was called the Paved Street District. The Lock Works was a factory at East Main and Ivy Streets where many Irish men worked.

The enumerator started at East Main Street, going south down Paved Street to the center of Stony Creek (pages 157A-158B). He proceeded along Stony Creek Road, included the few households at Pleasant Point and Pine Orchard. The route followed Totoket Road, to Damascus, and the few families living in Indian Neck. The census taker came back along the current South Montowese Street to Montowese Street in the center of town (pages 161B-162B). The families along Main and South Main Street were recorded and the enumerator continued along Main Street, past the current library to the Bradley Street area. Harbor Street was taken to Branford Point where a number of families lived along Harbor Street. Only a few families lived on the current Maple Street and at Double Beach. The census taker appears to have traveled along Alps Road, recorded a few families at the eastern end of Branford Hills, and came back toward Branford center by the current Harrison House. The rest of Branford Hills was then recorded and thence to East Main Street moving east to Mill Plain, North Branford Road to the Guilford line and back to the center of town. The census taker then went up to Brushy Plain, Short Rocks and recorded the few families living near Lake Saltonstall. The last page appears to be a random group of households, mostly in the center of town, perhaps those not recorded on the original day.
