First wife was Deborah Frisbie (1787-1858). Lived Bradley Street.

Bradley, Levi (1777-1855) son of Timothy & Sarah (Goodsell) Bradley
Wife was Lydia Beach (1781-1875). Lived Main Street near Bradley Street.

Whitney=Whiting, Mary (c1784-1842) nee Page, widow of Abel Whiting
Lived Mill Plain with her children. In the 1830 census.

Wilford, Anna (1758-1840) daughter of John & Rebecca (Baldwin) Blackstone, widow of John Wilford Lived Montowese Street. In 1830 census.

Wilford, Augustus=John A. (1783-1871) son of John & Anne (Blackstone) Wilford
A widower. Lived 7 Sybil Avenue, Indian Neck. In 1810, 1820 and 1830 census.

Wilford, John (1810-1872) son of John & Betsey (Frisbie) Wilford
Wife was Lucretia Goodenough (1813-1862). Lived Main Street next to his grandmother Anna.

Wilford, Samuel (1811-1883) son of John & Betsey (Frisbie) Wilford
Wife was Susan Cook (c1807-1849). Lived Sybil Avenue next to his father John Augustus.

Williams, Henry A. (1799-1872) son of Samuel & Amy (Moulthrop) Williams
Wife was Phebe Pond (c1800-1864). Lived Pleasant Point/Totoket Road.
In 1820 and 1830 census.

William, James age 29-30 with a wife and two sons. Lived Mill Plain.

1840 Federal Census 704, roll 27, pages 128A-137A

The enumerator for the 1840 Branford census was Ira Meriman. Census day was June 1, 1840 and the enumerator had 18 months to complete it. The pages are pre-printed so columns are better delineated than in previous census. For the first time, the Branford census does not include North Branford. Women are identified as head of household, even if adult males are in the household. The names are difficult to read due to the handwriting of the enumerator where several letters look alike, for example he does not cross a small "t" so it looks like a "l". Especially difficult is the first half of page 134 where the enumerator's pen was running out ink. There is some difficulty distinguishing certain names such as Josiah/Jonah/Sarah; Averill/Russell; Morris/Monro. Only a few abbreviations are used. This writer has again added the line numbers for easier identification.

The hash marks for the most part are clear except a few which might be "strays". There is difficulty distinguishing the number "2" which the enumerator writes more like a "1". It is difficult to correlate the names and entries on page two or "B" with the line on page "A". Page B has entries for pensioners, free colored persons, slaves and information about employment and schooling.

There are only two free colored heads of households in 1840 for Branford- Prince B. Warner and Jane Griffing. The remaining free colored persons are not named and lived

in other households, probably as servants or farm hands. They are listed below with the associated households:

Attached is this writer's interpretation of the genealogy of the people in the 1840 census. It is noted when relatives lived next to or near each other. The route the census taker took is not very consistent and is as follows:

page 128- A few families on the east end of Main Street, along East Main Street and a few families at Damascus.

page 129- Montowese Street and Branford center

page 130- North Branford Road, East Main at Mill Plain and Damascus

page 131- Bradley Street, Main Street to Branford Point

page 132- Near the Harrison House and onto Mill Plain and Short Rocks

page 133- Stony Creek, Mill Plain and Branford Hills

page 134- Main Street by the current library and back to Stony Creek

page 135- Damascus and Pine Orchard then back to Montowese Street

page 136- Branford center and Double Beach, a few families at Stony Creek

page 137- Near Lake Saltonstall and a few miscellany families, probably not checked during the initial trip
